Work might be at the fields, at the greenhouse and using a growth chamber at the lab.

Interns learn how to manage arable crops (cereals, potatoes, hemp, maize and others). They further learn how to plan, set up and carry out field experiments. They learn how to handle tractors and agricultural machines and to use research equipment.
